

SIGN-UP SHEET — the only place contact info gets written

Print several per booth/shift. This sheet is the entire consented-contact data model: nothing about a person is written anywhere else (walk sheets carry tallies only). Custody: sheets go to the shift captain at close, then to the Signal-lane steward; never photographed into group chats; originals stored offline. Our data-care rules govern: never shared, never sold, never published; removed on request.

Read aloud or point to this before anyone writes: "This puts you on our contact list only — volunteer-run, non-partisan neighbours organizing mutual aid and neighbourhood assemblies. We'll contact you the way you pick, we never share or publish the list, and you can ask to be removed any time at unitetolove@gmail.com."
